

To All Primary Parents,

I would like to welcome you all to the new 2011-2012 school year. We are planning another year filled with lots of activities and fun. The following list is for supplies needed by the 1<sup>st</sup> week of school for all students.

***For All Primary Students***

- ❖ *2 sets of extra clothes (i.e. underwear, shorts, t-shirts and socks). If your child has had to change their clothes, the bag with dirty clothes will be put outside the classroom door with your child's name on it. Make sure you return another set to the school. At all times we should have 2 sets of clothes here for emergencies.*
- ❖ *For the children who might be taking a nap in the afternoon, a sheet or a small blanket for a cover. We supply the mat, pillow and bottom sheet. **Please mark the sheet/small blanket with your child's name.** These items will be washed once a week.*
- ❖ *2 plastic envelopes for their "going home folder" with Velcro closing and their name on it.*
- ❖ *1 small, hardy indoor plant with your child's name on it.*

***Requested Donations***

- ❖ *1 hand pencil sharpener with a container to catch the shavings.*
- ❖ *2 reams of regular copy paper, we use this paper for coloring, copying and painting.*
- ❖ *2 boxes of Kleenex*
- ❖ *2 rolls of paper towels*
- ❖ *1 box of Ziploc bags either quart or gallon size*

***We do appreciate these donations to our school.***

All these items will be given to the teachers and they will distribute when needed. Make sure your children know the supplies are shared with the whole class.

For all students who are enrolled in the Private School and Charter School, we also require a \$100.00 donation to buy supplies for the classroom for the rest of the school year. This fee is due the first week of school and will pay for the monthly cook –a- lunch, gardening supplies and other classroom consumables like, paper cups, lunch dishes etc.
