

To All Primary Parents,

I would like to welcome you all to the new 2008-2009 school year. We are planning another year filled with lots of activities and fun. The following list is a request for donation and if parents cannot afford to buy these items they are not obligated to do so. We would like the following items brought to school during the first 2 months of the school year;

- ❖ *2 sets of extra clothes (i.e. underwear, shorts, t-shirts and socks). If your child has had to change their clothes, the bag with dirty clothes will be put outside the classroom door with your child's name on it. Make sure you return another set to the school. At all times we should have 2 sets of clothes here for emergencies.*
- ❖ *1 hand pencil sharpener with a container to catch the shavings.*
- ❖ *For the children who might be taking a nap in the afternoon, a sheet or a small blanket for a cover. We supply the mat, pillow and bottom sheet. **Please mark the sheet/small blanket with your child's name.** These items will be washed once a week.*
- ❖ *6 cans of 100% frozen juice cans and 2 boxes of crackers. This will be for snack the first couple of weeks. We will supply the juice and crackers after that.*
- ❖ *2 reams of regular copy paper, we use this paper for coloring, copying and painting.*
- ❖ *1 small, hardy indoor plant with your child's name on it.*
- ❖ *1 small lunch box, soft sided so it does not take up too much space in the refrigerator; make sure you put your child's name on it.*
- ❖ *2 boxes of Kleenex.*
- ❖ *1 roll of Saran Wrap or aluminum foil.*
- ❖ *2 boxes of zip lock bags, quart or sandwich size.*
- ❖ *1 pallet of very inexpensive water colors.*
- ❖ *1 bottle of tempura paint (yellow, red, or blue)*
- ❖ *3 rolls of scotch tape...the refill type for the dispensers in the classrooms.*
- ❖ *Small and medium sized post-its or sticky notes.*
- ❖ *1 box of staples for the standard staplers in the classrooms.*

***We do appreciate these donations to our school.***

All children will be given a plastic envelope to take home papers. This envelope needs to be returned every day. If your child loses the envelope you can purchase one for \$1.50 or buy one yourself.

All these items will be given to the teachers and they will distribute when needed. Make sure your children know the supplies are shared with the whole class.

For all students who are enrolled in the Charter School we would also like to ask for a \$75.00 donation to buy supplies for the classroom for the rest of the school year.

Donations are accepted throughout the year to help the class room budget so that the children can do special projects like cooking, gardening and arts and crafts.
